



School checklist: How can I act in response to my school's #BeeWell data?



Book your one-to-one session with the #BeeWell team: [#BeeWell GM school consultations](#). Make sure to invite members of the school team who may find it useful to join!



Share your data with colleagues, e.g. Senior Leadership Team, Heads of Year groups, physical activity data with the P.E department, arts & culture with arts department, etc.
